



Streetcar Track Renewal on College St. and Carlton St. Welding and storage of new streetcar rail

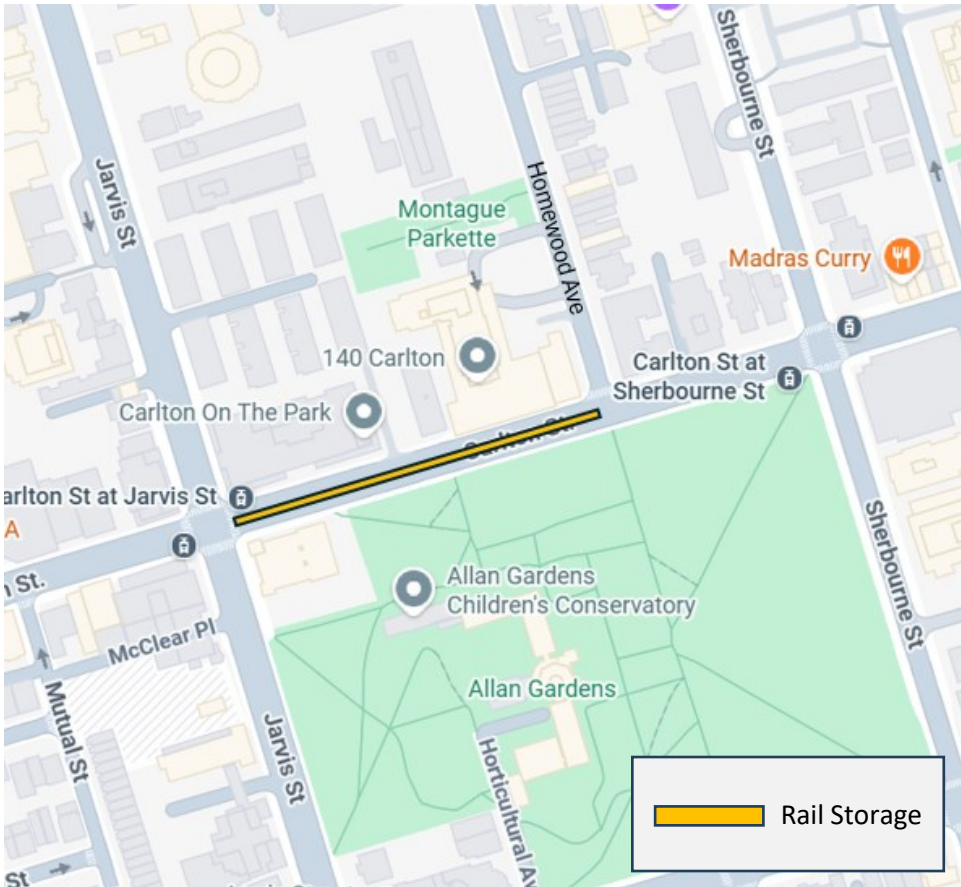
What we are doing and why

Starting as early as July 27, the City of Toronto and the TTC will be resuming construction along the College-Carlton corridor. As part of Phase 2, sewer will be replaced on College Street from Yonge Street to Bay Street, and TTC track will be replaced on Carlton Street from Church Street to Yonge Street. Rail welding and storage details

To support this next phase of work, TTC crews will be welding together standard lengths of rail into longer strings to facilitate faster track installation, thereby reducing the construction disruption to the local community. This work is currently scheduled to take place from Sunday, July 26 to Thursday, July 30 and will occupy the two centre lanes on **Carlton Street between Jarvis Street and Homewood Avenue**.

The long strings of rails will then be stored in the same area and deplete as track work and new rail installation progresses over the course of the project. Noise associated with welding and moving rail into position is to be expected. Temporary lane and parking restrictions will be required in this section until all new rail is installed.



Work hours and noise

Rail welding operations will be conducted around-the-clock. Some night work and deliveries of rail may be required to support the daytime welding operation.

To safely and efficiently move the long strings of rails, a night crew will pull the rails overnight with a Toronto police escort. Some noise can be expected during this activity.

Parking and traffic restrictions

- Rail welding and storage activities between Jarvis Street and Homewood Avenue will result in lane and parking restrictions in the immediate area.
- For safety, traffic controls will be in place.
- Access to businesses, properties, and laneways will be maintained.

TTC service – starting as early as July 27

TTC plans to adjust service to **506** **306** Carlton streetcars and **97C** Yonge buses as early as Monday, July 27, 2026.

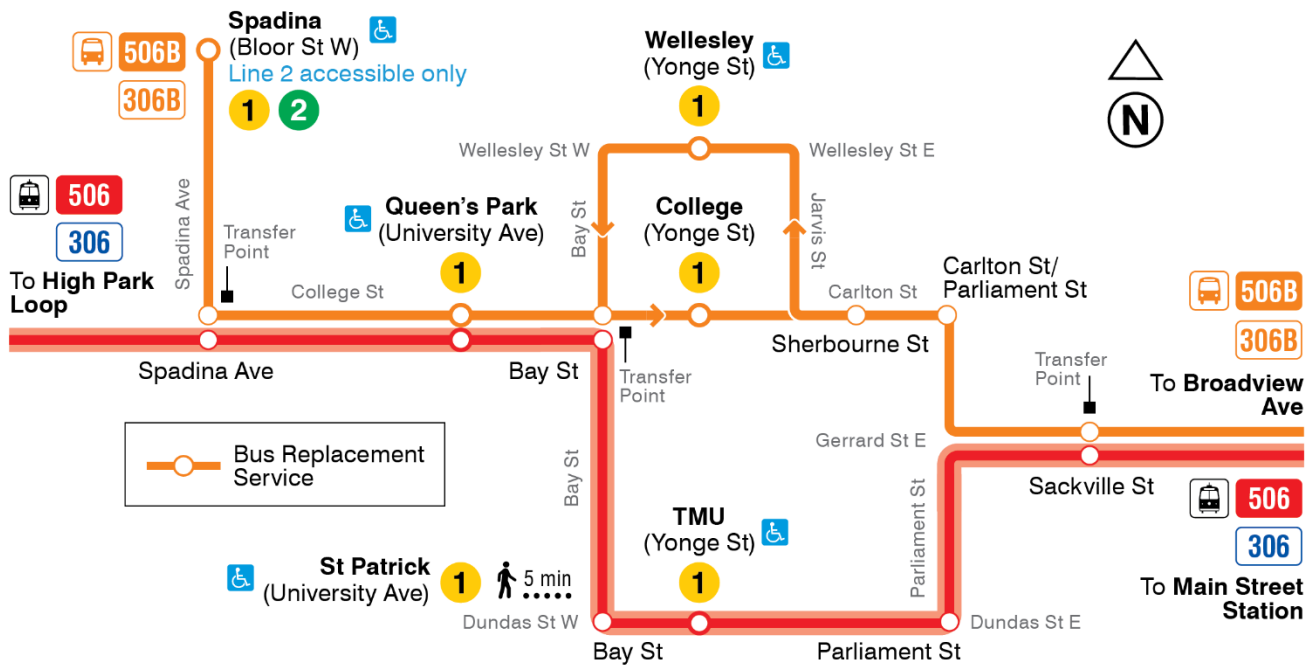
506 **306** **Carlton streetcars** will divert both ways via Bay Street, Dundas Street, and Parliament Street to regular routing.

A **506B** **306** **Carlton bus replacement** service will be introduced, operating between Spadina Station and Broadview and Gerrard via:

- **Eastbound:** Spadina Ave, College St, Carlton St, Parliament St, Gerrard St E.
Westbound: Gerrard St E, Parliament St, Jarvis St, Wellesley St, Bay St, College St, Spadina Ave.

97C **Yonge buses** will also divert to accommodate the work along College/Carlton:

- **Buses will divert both ways via:** Yonge St, Wellesley St E, Jarvis St, Shuter St.
