Service changes to 504C King and 504D/304D King replacement buses due to King Street East and Church Street intersection closure

TTC service changes:

Starting Monday, June 2, 2025, to August 2025

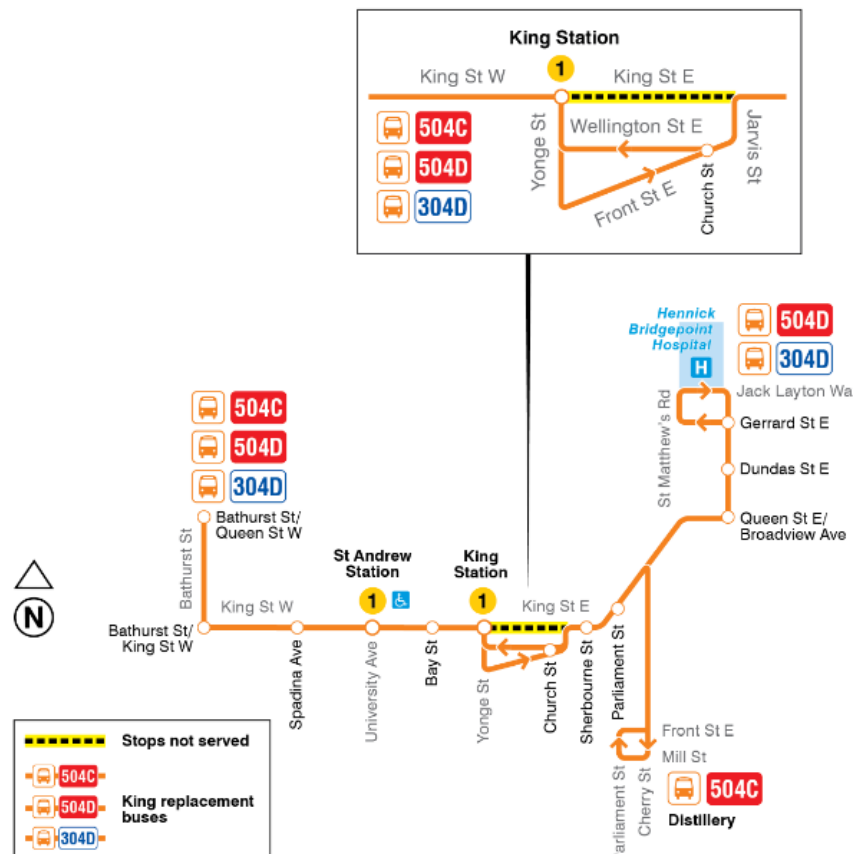
On **May 11, 2025**, City of Toronto crews began **replacing the 142-year-old watermain** at the intersection of King Street East and Church Street.

Starting **June 2, 2025**, the City of Toronto will close the King Street East and Church Street intersection to through traffic to complete watermain replacement on the south side of the intersection. This will be followed by streetcar track renewal that will be conducted by City of Toronto and TTC crews.

TTC route diversions

504C King and 504D/304D King replacement buses will divert around the intersection as follows:

- **Eastbound:** from King Street West and Yonge Street via south on Yonge Street, east on Front Street East, north on Jarvis Street to King Street East to resume regular routing.
- **Westbound:** from King Street East and Jarvis Street via south on Jarvis Street, west on Front Street East, west on Wellington Street East, north on Yonge Street to King Street West to resume regular routing.

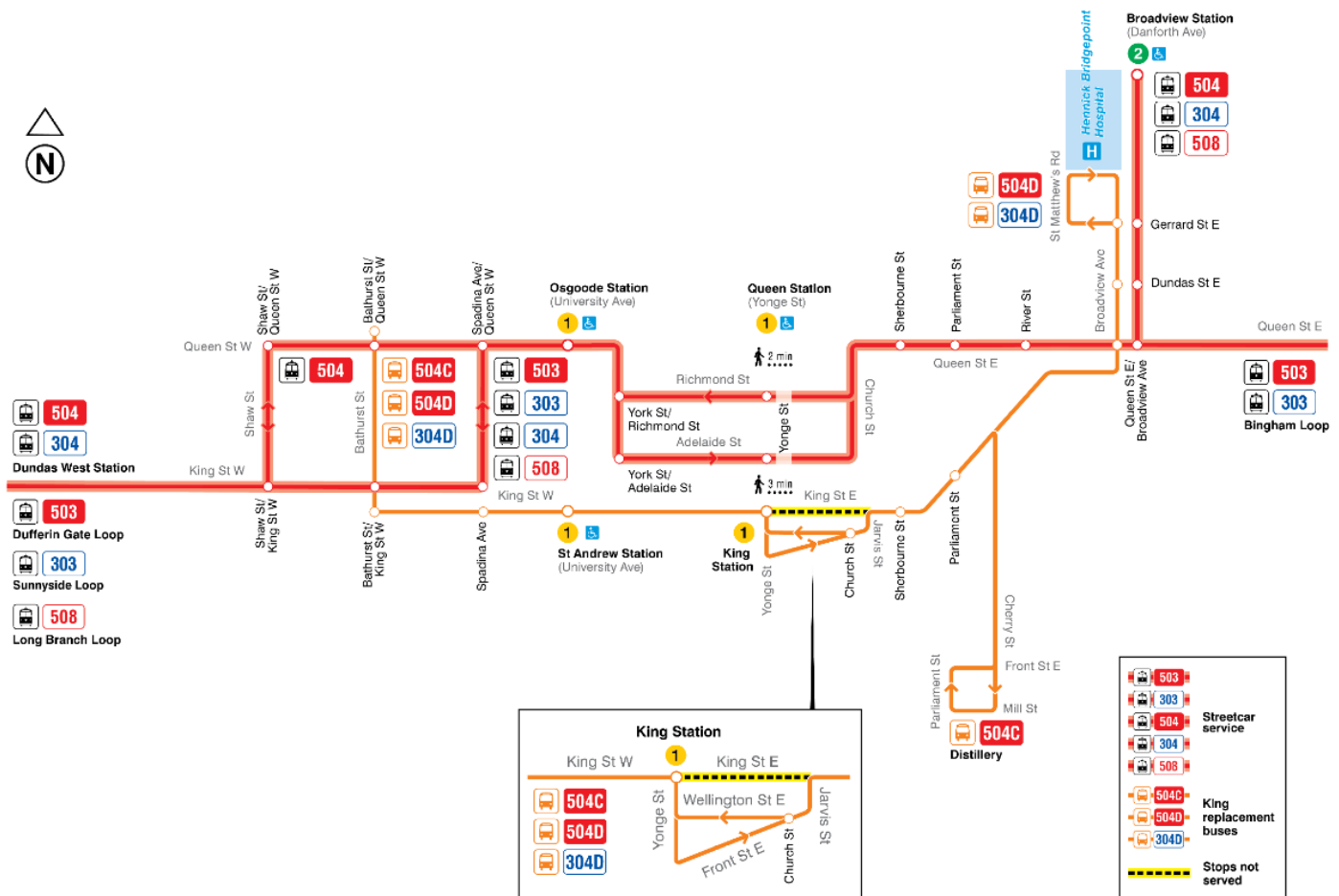

503/303 Kingston Rd, 508 Lake Shore streetcars and **304 King (Over Night) streetcars** will continue to operate via Queen Street between Broadview Avenue and Spadina Avenue, via Church Street, Adelaide Street/Richmond Street, and York Street.

504 King streetcars will continue to operate via Queen Street between Broadview Avenue and Shaw Street, via Church Street, Adelaide Street/Richmond Street, and York Street.

Wheel-Trans service will remain accessible in all areas where local traffic is permitted
