What we are doing

Starting as early as **mid-September 2025 (until late October 2025)**, the City of Toronto and TTC will begin renewing the streetcar tracks at the King Street West and Dufferin Street intersection as part of its state-of-good-repair program.

During construction, the King Street West and Dufferin Street intersection will be closed to cars and transit. Pedestrian access around the intersection will be maintained.

Work hours and construction-related noise

- Excavation and removal of old streetcar tracks will occur at various times throughout the day. Concrete milling and breaking activity will mainly occur between 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.
- TTC crews will work <u>around the clock</u> (24/7) during the rail installation work phase to preserve the integrity and quality of the newly installed streetcar rail and freshly poured concrete.
- Some overnight work/noise should be expected.

Rail delivery and storage

Before work begins, TTC crews will deliver new pre-cast streetcar rail on flatbed trailers. The trailers containing the new rail will be parked at or near the work zone. Affected properties will receive additional information.

TTC service changes

From as early as **mid-September 2025 to late October 2025**, the TTC will adjust streetcar and bus service to safely complete construction at the King Street West and Dufferin Street intersection:

- 29/329 Dufferin buses will divert to King Street West at Joe Shuster Way via Queen Street West and Shaw Street.
- 929 Dufferin buses will be shortened to Queen Street West.
- 503 Kingston Rd replacement buses will be shortened, operating between King Street West at Joe Shuster Way, and Kingston Road at Victoria Park Avenue (Bingham Loop).
- 504/304 King and 508 Lake Shore streetcars will divert via Queen Street West between Shaw Street and Roncesvalles Avenue. 504B King streetcars will be shortened to Bathurst Street.

Community bus and Wheel-Trans service

- 402 Parkdale community buses will continue to operate regular routing in Parkdale during construction.
- Wheel-Trans services will continue to operate in all areas where local traffic is permitted.

- To travel west or east, towards downtown:
 - Walk north to Queen and board a 501/301 Queen, 504/304 King, or 508 Lake Shore streetcar
- To travel east along King, towards downtown:
 - Board an eastbound 503 Kingston Rd bus at King and Joe Shuster.
- To travel north:
 - Board a northbound 29/329 Dufferin bus at King and Joe Shuster.


