Temporary changes to parking rules on sections of King St. W., Mowat Ave., Liberty St., and Fraser St.

Timeline:

As early as **September 22**, **2025**, City of Toronto and Toronto Parking Authority (TPA) crews will temporarily change parking signs (and parking meters) on sections of King Street West, Mowat Avenue, Liberty Street, and Fraser Street.

What we are doing

Starting as early as **September 22, 2025, and continuing until late October 2025,** the City and TTC will renew the streetcar tracks at the intersection of King Street West and Dufferin Street, requiring a full closure to traffic. During this time, **504/504A King** and **508 Lake Shore streetcars**, as well as **29/929 Dufferin buses**, will be diverted around the intersection. **29 Dufferin buses**, in particular, will be diverted through Liberty Village via Queen Street West, Shaw Street, and King Street West. The buses will use Mowat Avenue, Liberty Street, and Fraser Avenue to loop back to King Street West.

To support the **29 Dufferin bus** diversion during construction, City Council has approved extending/implementing temporary 'No Stopping' restrictions on certain streets in Liberty Village. The changes are intended to facilitate bus turns and end-of-line operations. These changes will be lifted once construction is complete and regular TTC service resumes in late October 2025.

Locations where 'No Stopping' restrictions are being temporarily installed in Liberty Village

- On Mowat Avenue:
 - o From King Street West to Liberty Street, in both curb lanes: at all times.
- On King Street West:
 - From Mowat Avenue to Joe Shuster Way, in the north curb lane: at all times.
 - o From Shaw Street to 20 meters west, in the north curb lane: at all times.
- On Fraser Avenue
 - o From King Street West to 100 metres south, in both curb lanes: at all times.
 - From Liberty Street to 21 meters north, in the east curb lane: at all times.
- On Liberty Street:
 - From Mowat Avenue to Fraser Street, in the south curb lane: at all times.


