Temporary changes to parking rules on Queen St. W. from Shaw St. to Roncesvalles Ave., and on Shaw St. from Queen St. W. to King St. W.

Timeline:

As early as **September 19, 2025**, City of Toronto and Toronto Parking Authority (TPA) crews will temporarily change the parking signs (parking meters) on Queen Street West and Shaw Street.

What we are doing

Starting as early as **September 22, 2025, and continuing until late October 2025**, the City and TTC will renew the streetcar tracks at the intersection of King Street West and Dufferin Street, fully closing the intersection to traffic. During this time, **504/504A King** and **508 Lake Shore streetcars** and **29/929 Dufferin buses** will be diverted around the intersection. These diversions will increase streetcar and bus traffic along Queen Street West and Shaw Street.

To help maintain efficient transit service and reduce traffic congestion on Queen Street West and Shaw Street during the planned closure of the King Street West and Dufferin Street intersection, City Council approved temporary parking changes in July 2025. These adjustments include extending 'No Stopping' rules on Queen Street West from Roncesvalles Avenue to Shaw Street, as well as implementing new restrictions on Shaw Street from Queen Street West to King Street West. The changes are intended to keep curb lanes clear during rush hours and support the diversion of TTC vehicles. These changes will be lifted once construction is complete and regular TTC service resumes in late October 2025.

Changes to 'No Stopping' restrictions on Queen Street West (Roncesvalles to Shaw)

EXISTING 'No Stopping' restrictions	NEW temporary 'No Stopping' restrictions
Monday to Friday in both curb lanes from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. (west of Dufferin Street) and 7 a.m. to 10 a.m. (east of Dufferin Street) AND from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. (west of Dufferin Street) and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. (east of Dufferin Street)	Monday to Friday in both curb lanes AND Saturday and Sunday in the south curb lane ONLY: from 7 a.m. to 11 a.m. AND from 2 p.m. to 7 p.m. *Parking is prohibited during these hours*

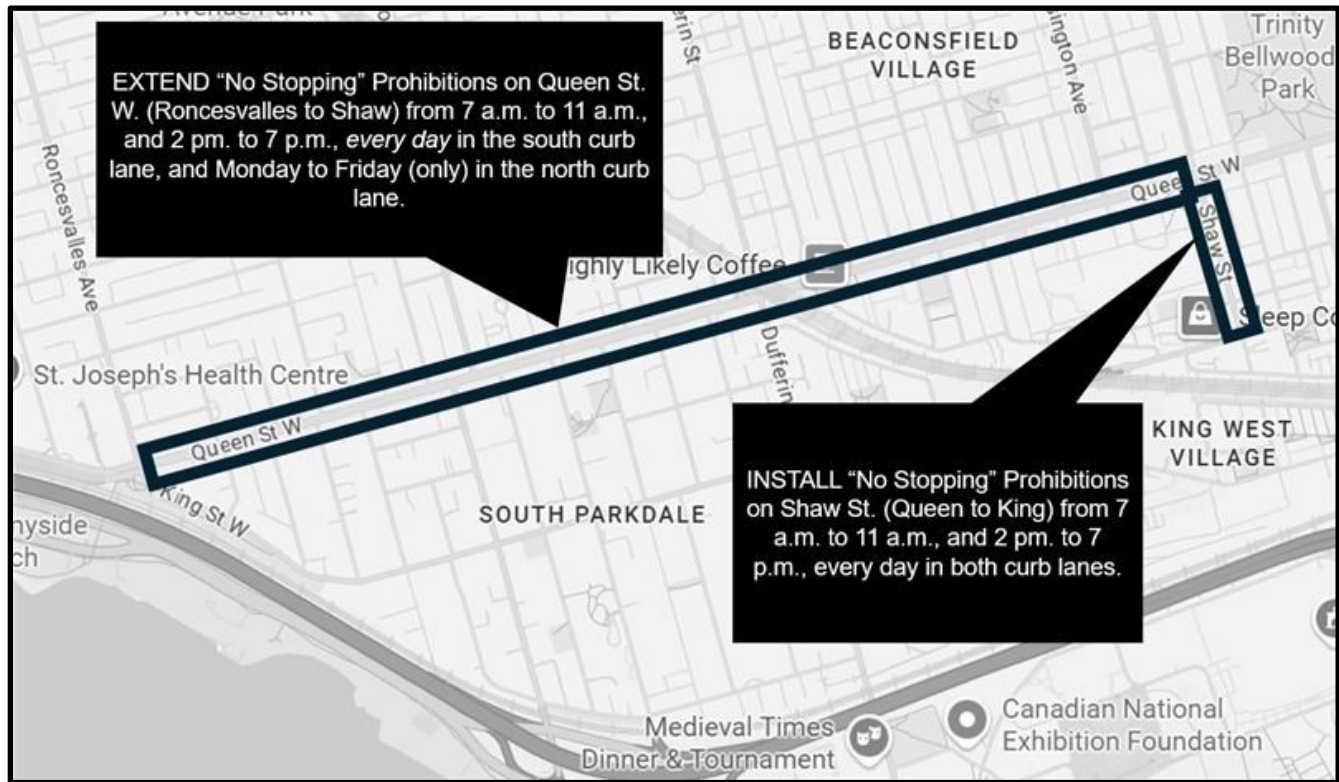

Monday to Sunday, every day in both curb lanes from 7 a.m. to 11 a.m. AND 2 p.m. to 7 p.m.



Timeline of changes to parking signs and meters (pay and display machines)

- Starting as early as **September 19, 2025**, City of Toronto and TPA crews will update the applicable parking signage and meters.
- Staff will occupy the curb lane to complete their work with limited impact on traffic.
