Delivery and storage of new streetcar rail panels

Timeline: July 6, July 15, July 16, and overnight from July 16 to 17, 2026

Rail Delivery and Storage Details

Beginning in June 2026, the TTC is renewing the streetcar tracks at Long Branch Loop and the west intersection of Lake Shore Boulevard West and Browns Line. To support this work, the TTC will deliver new streetcar rail panels and trailers to the site between **7 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Monday, July 6, 2026, Wednesday, July 15, and Thursday, July 16**, and between **11 p.m. and 5 a.m. on Thursday, July 16, and Friday, July 17, 2026**.

The rail panels will be delivered on flat-deck trailers for eventual installation at the Long Branch Loop. The flat-bed trailers will be stored in the centre lanes along Lake Shore Boulevard West at Browns Line (see the map on the reverse of this page). The flat-bed trailers will be removed once the new rail panels are installed. Trailers will be staged on the north side of Lake Shore Boulevard West at Browns Line until construction is completed.

Noise

- While crews will try to keep noise to a minimum during delivery, backup alarms on trucks and equipment will produce beeping sounds.
- Equipment lights will also be visible.

Travel and Parking Impacts

- Periodic lane reductions may be required at Lake Shore Boulevard West and Browns Line.
- One lane of traffic will be maintained in both directions, and all turn movements will be maintained. Periodic pedestrian and bicycle detours will be required.
- To maintain a safe work zone, street parking may be temporarily restricted during this work.

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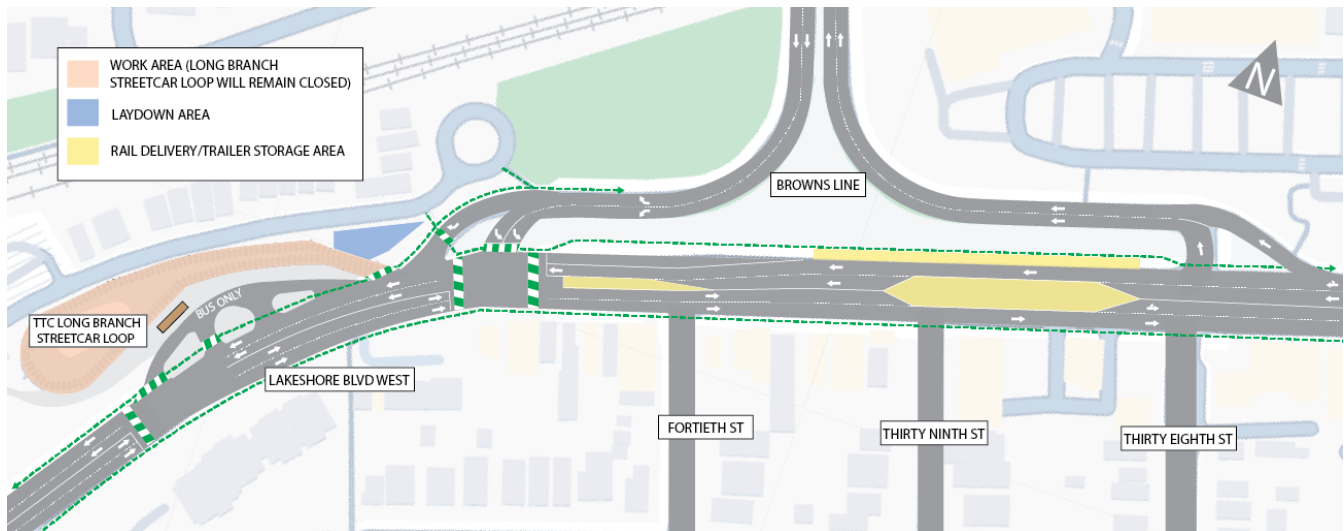


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Map of work zone and flat-deck trail storage locations
