



## TTC Track Renewal Queen Street East from Davies to Broadview

**Timeline: Starting as early as Monday, February 23, 2026**

### What we are doing and why

The majority of the watermain replacement has been completed. Starting as early as **Monday, February 23**, the streetcar track renewal phase of the project will begin and involve excavation, removal of old concrete and rail, and preparing the area for new rail installation. **Only one eastbound lane will be maintained through the work zone on Queen Street East during this work.**

Following rail installation, TTC will test and commission the new rail and overhead system before regular streetcar service resumes.

### Rail welding and storage

To support this next phase of work, TTC crews will weld together standard lengths of rail into longer strings to facilitate faster track installation, thereby reducing the construction disruption to local communities. This work is currently scheduled to begin on **Sunday, February 22** and will occupy two centre lanes on **Queen Street East, west of Davies Avenue (the Don Valley Parkway Bridge)**. Access to the DVP ramp will be maintained.

The long strings of rails will then be stored in the same area and deplete as track work and new rail installation progresses. Noise associated with welding and moving rail into position is to be expected.



### Work hours during new rail installation on Queen Street East

The noisiest work such as concrete breaking will occur at the beginning of this phase during daytime hours. Around-the-clock activities during rail installation by TTC is required to preserve the integrity and quality of new rail and concrete. Overnight rail work by TTC may consist of moving new rail into position, rail installation and rail welding / grinding.



# Construction Update



## TTC service adjustments during track work – starting February 23

- **501/301 Queen streetcars** will continue to divert via Broadview Avenue, Dundas Street East, and Parliament Street.
- **504B/304 King streetcars** will continue to operate as far east as Distillery Loop.
- **Eastbound 301B Queen, 503 Kingston Rd and 504 King replacement buses** will maintain their existing diversions.
  - **Westbound 301B Queen buses** will divert via Dundas Street East and River Street
  - **Westbound 503 Kingston Rd buses** will divert via Broadview Avenue, Eastern Avenue, Front Street East, and Parliament Street.
  - **Westbound 504 King buses** will divert via Broadview Avenue, Dundas Street East, and River Street.
- **505 Dundas streetcars** and 121 River-Esplanade buses stay on regular routing during this project.
- **Wheel-Trans service** will be maintained.
