

Warden Station Redevelopment Project

Temporary bus loop closure and bus bay changes

► Effective September 6, 2026, until early-2027.

What we're doing and why

As part of the TTC's **Easier Access program**, which is making subway stations across the city accessible, Warden Station is being completely rebuilt with a new bus terminal featuring plenty of natural light, more accessible platforms and improved signage and wayfinding.

The new permanent accessible bus terminal is scheduled to partially open to customers in early-2027, with a full opening by the **end of 2027**.

Starting **September 6, 2026**, the temporary bus loop will be closed and bus routes will serve the station from the bays (on-street stops) listed below.

Southbound **16 McCowan** and **17 Birchmount** buses will be adjusted to service Warden Station on street via Birchmount Road, Danforth Road, Mack Avenue and Warden Avenue.

Where to find your bus

Bay 2	8 Broadview (9 Bellamy drop-offs)
Bay 3	68 Warden, 968 Warden Express
Bay 4	Drop-offs: 68 Warden, 102 Markham Rd, 117 Birchmount South, 902 Markham Rd Express, 968 Warden Express
Bay 5	Wheel-Trans, 16 McCowan, 17 Birchmount, 69 Warden South, 135 Gerrard

Fencing and signage will guide you between the on-street stops and the station entrance – approximately 250 m, or a three-minute walk, to/from the furthest stop.

Warden Station is AODA accessible, with two elevators in service:

- Passenger Pick-Up/Drop-Off (street level) to station concourse
- Station concourse to subway platform level

A dedicated Wheel-Trans stop is located at Bay 5. The temporary bus stops are outdoors and on-street, and remain fully accessible.
