Service changes to the 509 Harbourfront streetcar

TTC service changes:

Starting Sunday, March 30, 2025, until further notice *Content/timeline accurate at the time of printing

What's happening at Bathurst Street, Fleet Street, and Lake Shore Boulevard West?

Since late February 2025, City of Toronto and TTC work crews have been undertaking infrastructure upgrades in the Bathurst Street and Lake Shore Boulevard West area.

City crews have been undertaking watermain replacement work and joint City and TTC crews have been conducting streetcar track renewal work.

This work is required to restore this City and TTC infrastructure to good repair.

NEW TTC service diversions, effective March 30, 2025

509 Harbourfront streetcars

Starting **March 30, 2025, 509 Harbourfront streetcars** will be temporarily suspended. Service will be maintained by **510A Spadina streetcars**, which will operate between Spadina Station and Union Station.

509B Harbourfront replacement buses

509B Harbourfront replacement buses will continue to operate as follows:

- Eastbound: from Exhibition Loop via east Fleet Street, north and east Fort York Boulevard, south Bathurst Street, east Housey Street, south Dan Leckie Way, and east Queens Quay West to Spadina Avenue
- Westbound: from Spadina Avenue and Queens Quay West via west Queens Quay West, north Bathurst Street, west and south Fort York Boulevard, west Lake Shore Boulevard West, north Strachan Avenue, and west Manitoba Drive to Exhibition Loop.

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
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Please note that the current diversion on the **511 Bathurst streetcar** and **511B Bathurst replacement bus routes** (in effect since February 16, 2025) will not change.
