



TTC streetcar track renewal Bathurst Street and Lake Shore Boulevard West Rail delivery and storage

What we are doing and why

On March 4, 2025, TTC crews will begin delivering new streetcar rail for installation along Bathurst Street and at the Bathurst Street and Lake Shore Boulevard West intersection.

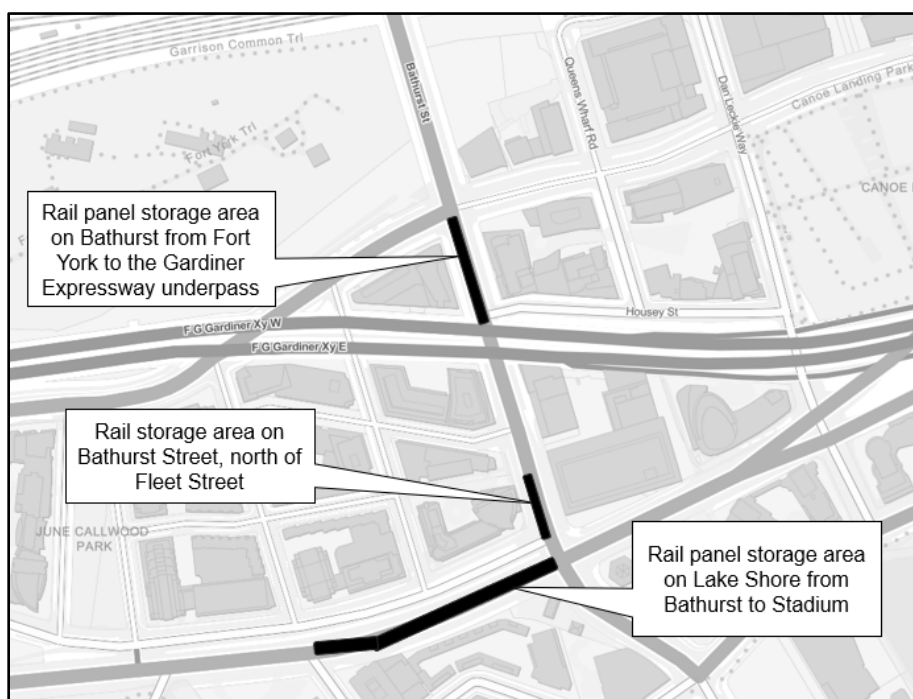
The stored rail will be depleted as crews install them along Bathurst Street, and at the Bathurst Street and Lake Shore Boulevard West intersection

Rail delivery details

- The first delivery will occur between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. on March 4, 2025. This set of rails will be stored on Bathurst Street, north of Fleet Street in the southbound curb lane.
- The second delivery will occur (nightly), between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m., from March 5 to March 8, 2025. These rail panels will be delivered on flat-deck trailers and parked/stored:
 - North of the contractor's work zone, between Fort York Boulevard and the Gardiner Expressway underpass
 - In the two westbound lanes on Lake Shore Boulevard West, between Bathurst Street and Stadium Road.
- For safety reasons, the trailers will be transported to the area with a police escort between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Noise

While the crew will try to keep noise to a minimum, beeping sounds from backup alarms on trucks and equipment will be audible. Equipment lights may also be noticeable.
