



Service changes to the 509B Harbourfront replacement bus

TTC service changes:

Starting Monday, March 3, 2025, until further notice

What's happening at Bathurst Street, Fleet Street, and Lake Shore Boulevard West?

Starting **Monday, March 3, 2025**, the City of Toronto and the TTC will begin renewing the streetcar tracks along Bathurst Street, from Housey Street to just south of Lake Shore Boulevard West and a small section of Fleet Street at Bathurst Street. This work is required to restore city infrastructure to good repair and is part of the City Council's approved 2024 Capital Works Program.

The TTC will deliver new streetcar rails to the site before streetcar track work begins. Delivery is expected to take place the week of March 3. The new rails will be stored immediately north of the active work zone on the streetcar tracks (right of way) from just south of the Gardiner Expressway overpass to Fort York Boulevard.

New TTC service diversions

To accommodate the next construction phase, the TTC will adjust the **509B Harbourfront replacement bus** routing between Spadina Avenue and Exhibition Loop. **509 Harbourfront streetcars** will continue to operate from Union Station to Spadina Avenue and Queens Quay.

Please note that the current diversion on the **511 Bathurst streetcar** and **511B Bathurst replacement bus routes** (in effect since February 17) will not change.

Wheel-Trans service will remain accessible in all areas where local traffic is permitted.

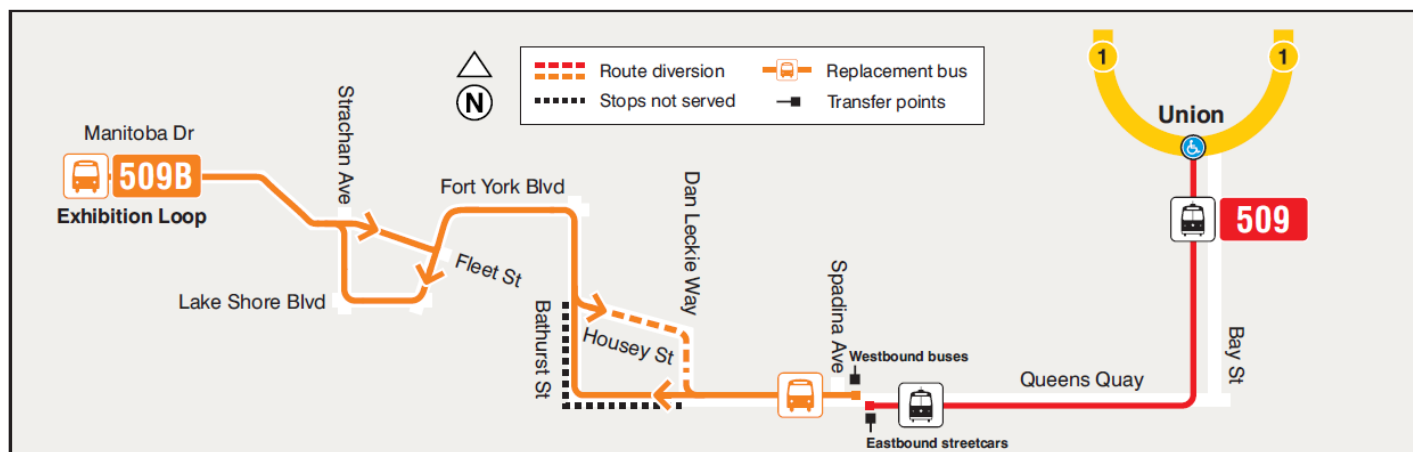

509 Harbourfront streetcars will continue to operate from Union Station to Queens Quay West at Spadina Avenue.

509B

509B Harbourfront replacement buses will continue to operate from Queens Quay West at Spadina Avenue to Exhibition Loop, with eastbound buses now diverting via Housey Street and Dan Leckie Way. Buses will operate as follows:

- **Eastbound:** from Exhibition Loop via east Fleet Street, north and east Fort York Boulevard, south Bathurst Street, east Housey Street, south Dan Leckie Way, and east Queens Quay West to Spadina Avenue
- **Westbound:** from Spadina Avenue and Queens Quay West via west Queens Quay West, north Bathurst Street, west and south Fort York Boulevard, west Lake Shore Boulevard West, north Strachan Avenue, and west Manitoba Drive to Exhibition Loop.



Changes to the 509 Harbourfront and 511 Bathurst streetcar routes set to start on March 30, 2025, until June 22, 2025, will be communicated in a subsequent Transit Notice.
