



Old Mill Station Easier Access Project Catch Basin Relocation

Timeline:

Catch basin relocation to make Old Mill Station accessible will begin as early as August 25, 2025, and is estimated to be completed by September 12, 2025*

What we are doing and why:

The TTC's Easier Access Program is making subway stations accessible. Construction to make Old Mill Station accessible with two new elevators is ongoing. Elevators are scheduled to be in service in 2028*.

Beginning on August 25, 2025, crews will begin relocation of the catch basin located on 39 Old Mill Road property, northeast of the station. This work is necessary as part of the Old Mill Easier Access Project.

What to expect:

- Construction trucks, equipment, and site staff will be present in the area during the work hours.
- Most of the work is expected to be completed within the hoarded area.
- The traffic lane on Old Mill Road will be temporarily reduced from two lanes to one lane during working hours to safely complete the relocation of the catch basin. Please note that temporarily, there may be some road closures at the site of construction, and traffic personnel will redirect vehicles during this time.
- After hours, the traffic barrels will be removed, the excavation will be covered with steel plates, and two-way traffic will be restored. We kindly ask that all motorists exercise caution as they pass over these plates, as they may produce some noise.

Traffic, pedestrian, and cyclist restrictions:

- During the temporary reduction of the lane at Old Mill Road signage, traffic cones, and flag persons will be present.
- Access to Old Mill Station will be maintained for customers throughout construction.
- The 2662 Bloor Street visitors' parking spots within the construction area will not be available for the duration of construction.
- The visitor parking spots outside the construction zone will be available.
- Access to the underground parking garages at 39 Old Mill Road and 2662 Bloor Street West will be maintained throughout construction.
- The pedestrian pathway from 39 Old Mill Road leading to Old Mill Station will remain open. The sidewalk within the construction area at 2662 Bloor Street West will be closed.
- Construction vehicles will access the Old Mill Easier Access construction site from Old Mill Trail and Bloor Street West via Breezeway.
- Signage to direct traffic will be placed.

- TTC buses will run regularly at Old Mill Station.
- No impacts to subway service on Line 2 – Bloor Danforth.
