



Old Mill Station Easier Access Project Shoring and Micropiles Installation

Timeline:

Shoring and micropiles installation to make Old Mill Station accessible will begin as early as September 23, 2025, and is scheduled to be completed in Q1 2026*

What we are doing and why:

The TTC's Easier Access Program is making subway stations accessible. Construction to make Old Mill Station accessible with two new elevators is ongoing. Elevators are scheduled to be in service in the end of 2028*.

Beginning as early as September 23, 2025, crews will begin shoring and micropiles installation to facilitate the excavation process and support the structure of the new elevator shafts.

What to expect:

- Construction trucks, equipment, and site staff will be present in the area.
- A drill rig, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, dump trucks, and a crane will be on site for the shoring and micropiles installation.
- Noise, dust, and vibration associated with construction can be expected with this work. Efforts will be made to keep levels to a minimum, and monitoring will be in place.
- Scaffolding will be installed to deflect the noise.
- Work will take place within the hoarded area.

Traffic, pedestrian, and cyclist restrictions:

- Access to Old Mill Station will be maintained for customers throughout construction.
- The 2662 Bloor Street visitors' parking spots within the construction area will not be available for the duration of construction.
- The visitor parking spots outside the construction zone will be available.
- Access to the underground parking garages at 39 Old Mill Road and 2662 Bloor Street West will be maintained throughout construction.
- The pedestrian pathway from 39 Old Mill Road leading to Old Mill Station will remain open. The sidewalk within the construction area at 2662 Bloor Street West will be closed.
- Construction vehicles will access the Old Mill Easier Access construction site from Old Mill Trail and Bloor Street West via Breezeway.
- Signage to direct traffic will be placed.
