



## Improving Transit along Dundas St. W. from McCaul St. to Spadina Ave.

**Parking changes: July 2024 to January 1, 2025**

### Efforts to improve travel for all road users on Dundas Street West from McCaul Street to Spadina Avenue

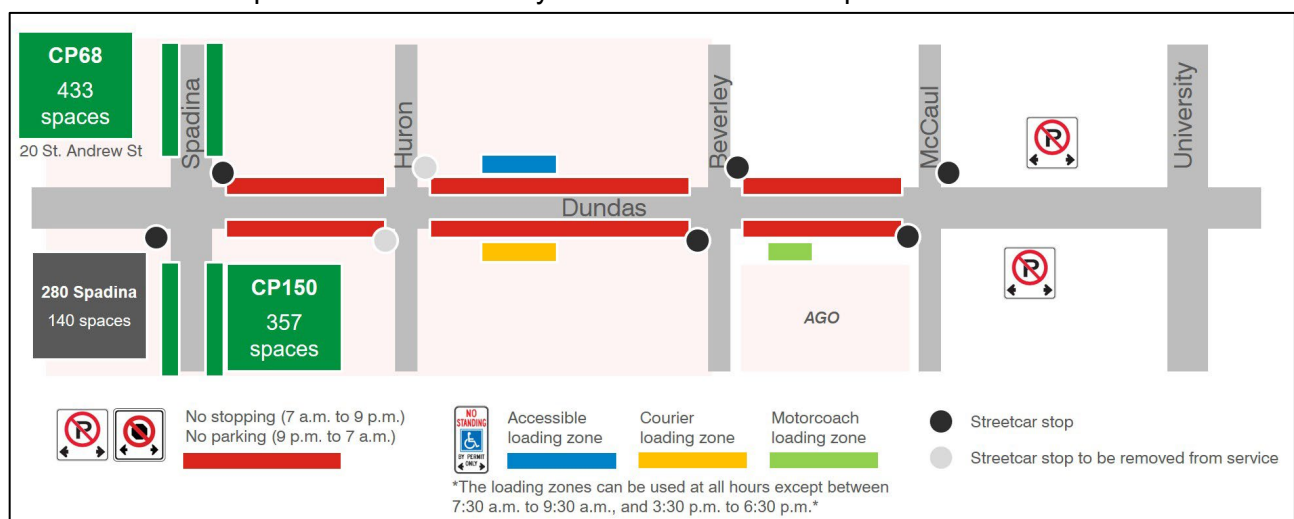
Dundas Street West is a critical corridor for all road users across the city. The 505 Dundas streetcar in particular is crucial in moving people across Dundas Street West - over **185,000 customers** ride the 505 Dundas streetcar every week.

The section of Dundas Street West from Spadina Avenue to McCaul Street is often congested. While Spadina Avenue to Bay Street is only 10% of the 505 Dundas route, at its worst performance, this section contributes to anywhere between 40% to 50% of the route's delays.

To support public transit and traffic flow on Dundas Street West, on **May 22, 2024** City Council directed City Transportation and TTC to implement by-law changes related to traffic on Dundas Street West between McCaul Street and Spadina Avenue ([Item - 2024.TE13.42](#)).

### Starting in mid July, the following changes on Dundas Street West between Spadina Avenue and McCaul Street will be in effect:

- **No Stopping 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., No Parking 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.**
- All areas east and west of here remain the same.
- Existing motorcoach loading zones on the south side of Dundas Street West, east of Beverley Street will remain. They can be used at all hours except between 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Accessible loading zones and courier zones will be established on Dundas Street east of Huron Street, as shown below. They can be used at all hours except between 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Starting July 28, the streetcar stops at Dundas Street West and Huron Street will be temporarily removed to improve service reliability. All other streetcar stops will remain.



### Other important details:

- Parking on Spadina Avenue will be **maintained**.
- 505 Dundas streetcars will continue to operate on Dundas Street.
- 357 parking spaces are **available** at Green P #150 on the south-east side of Dundas/Spadina. 433 parking spaces are **available** at Green P #68 at 20 St. Andrew Street.
- Green P #150:
  - \$2.50/half hour, every day; Day Max. (7 a.m. – 6 p.m.): \$10.00, Night Max. (6 p.m. – 7 a.m.): \$8.00
- Green P #68:
  - \$3/half hour, every day; Day Max. (7 a.m. – 6 p.m.): \$12.00, Night Max. (6 p.m. – 7 a.m.): \$8.00

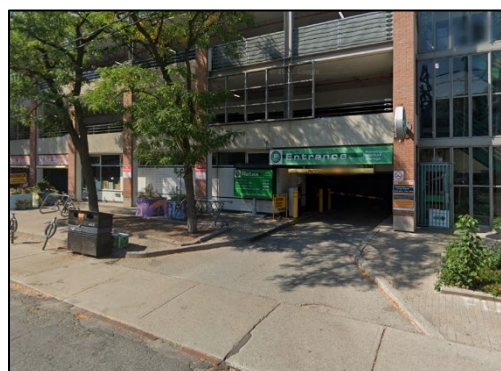
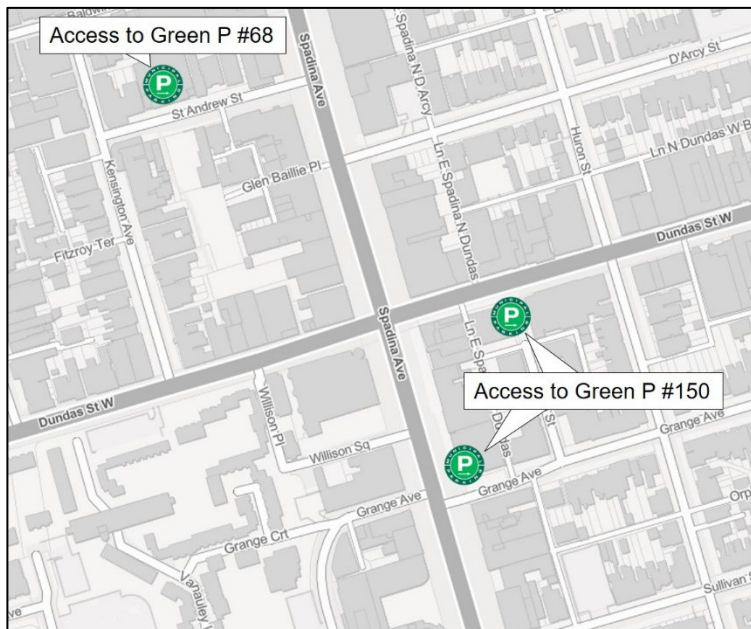
