



St Clair Station Temporary Bus Bay Closure Lower platform bus entrance on Pleasant Boulevard closed

What we are doing and why?

On November 11th and 12th 2023, the lower platform bus entrance on Pleasant Boulevard at St Clair Station will be closed from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. to deliver and install trailers for utility relocation. The trailers will be located at the northeast corner of the bus loop.

What to expect - **Temporary local bus boarding location – for 74, 88 and 97)**

- Trailers will be delivered and installed at the northeast corner of St Clair Bus Bay. Work will be performed with the assistance of a mobile crane.
- **All bus routes (74 Mount Pleasant, 88 South Leaside and 97 Yonge) and Wheel-Trans passengers will board on Pleasant Boulevard, south of the station. Customer service representatives will be present to assist passengers.**
- Bus boarding location for 512 St Clair will **NOT** change
- Wayfinding and station signage will be posted to guide customers to the correct boarding areas.
- The accessibility presto fare gate at St Clair Station (Bus Level) will be open for customers entering from street level at Pleasant Boulevard.

Traffic, pedestrian and cyclist impacts

- Traffic will be maintained, with no lane closures.
- Access to the station and subway service will be maintained.
- Parking enforcement and a tow truck will be present to allow TTC buses to park along Pleasant Boulevard.
- A dedicated supervisor will be on-site to ensure no parking of vehicles on the south side of Pleasant Boulevard.
- TTC will make efforts to mitigate bus idling on Pleasant Boulevard.

Noise, vibration, and work hours

Noise, dust and vibration associated with construction can be expected with this work. Efforts will be made to keep levels to a minimum. The majority of the work will take place between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
