What we are doing

In order to reduce noise from streetcar operations, starting as early as **Thursday, November 16 2023**, TTC track crews will be conducting excavation at Yonge Street and St Clair Avenue West for streetcar lubricator upgrades. The work is expected to be complete by approximately Wednesday, November 22.

Work hours

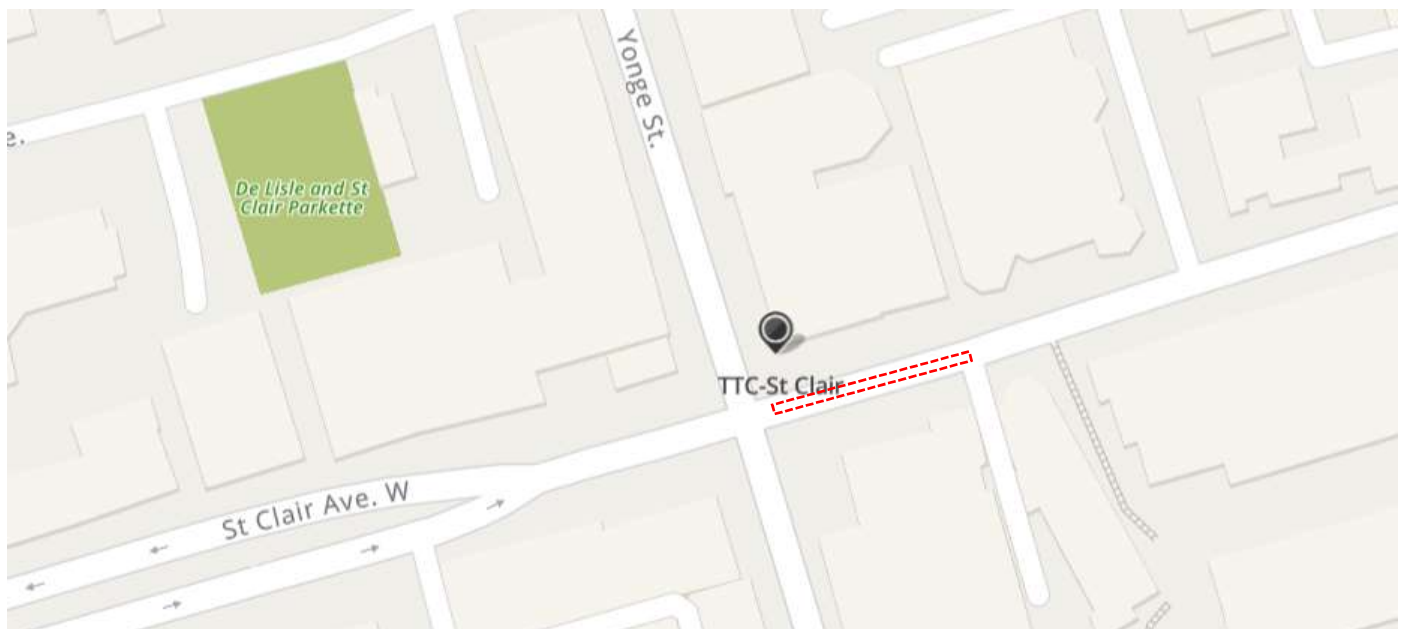
- Concrete breaking/excavation work will **typically end at 11 p.m.**
- Some noise, dust, and vibration associated with construction is unavoidable. Efforts will be made to minimize.

Traffic and transit impact

- The crew will be occupying the streetcar tracks on St. Clair Avenue West in front of St. Clair Station, just east of Yonge Street. Curb lanes will be maintained in each direction.

Pedestrian impact

- Access to station entrance will be maintained.
