RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Commission receive this report for information. It lists Expenditures (\$1,000,000 up to \$5,000,000) for the period October 1, 2009 to October 31, 2009 which were approved by the Chief General Manager.

BACKGROUND

The Corporate Policy on Authorization for Expenditures requires a monthly report of expenditures over \$1,000,000 approved by Senior Management, which did not require specific Commission authorization.

All these purchases are made in accordance with the TTC's Procurement Policy.

DISCUSSION

The attached summary was prepared for the Commission listing those expenditures of \$1,000,000 to \$5,000,000 without specific Commission authorization for the period October 1, 2009 to October 31, 2009. In addition, a sole source report is attached which lists sole source expenditures which were appropriately approved, but were inadvertently omitted from past reports to the Commission. Previously staff manually tracked sole source purchases for reporting purposes, but discovered the omissions while preparing an automated system to track and report sole source purchases. This new tracking system is now in place.
