RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Commission:

1. Re-confirm the Wednesday, July 22, 2009 and Wednesday, August 26, 2009 meeting dates, as approved at the December 17, 2008 meeting.

OR

2. Cancel the Wednesday, June 24, 2009 and Wednesday, July 22, 2009 meeting dates and approve a Thursday, July 9, 2009 meeting date to conform to the last City Council meeting for the summer, which will be held on July 6 and 7, 2009.

DISCUSSION

At its meeting on Wednesday, December 17, 2008, the Commission adopted its 2009 meeting schedule, and requested staff to review the possibility of changing the dates for the July and August meetings to facilitate more consistency with the City schedule.

The following summary responds to this request:

CURRENT MEETING DATE	EXAMINATION OF POSSIBLE CHANGES
July 22, 2009	Cancel July 22, 2009 meeting and reschedule to July 9, 2009. With this change, it will be necessary to cancel the June 24, 2009 due to insufficient time between the June 24 th and July 9th meetings.
	Creates a six week gap between the May 28 th and July 9 th meetings, as well as, the July 9 th and August 26 th meetings. Additional interim approvals may be necessary outside of the formal Commission meeting process due to extra time between meetings.
	Based on a canvass of individual Commissioners, changing the July 22 nd meeting to July 9 th is a viable option for consideration.

August 26, 2009	Change to the current meeting date of August 26, 2009 is
	not recommended. Options for moving the meeting into
	September are virtually impossible due to agenda timing
	issues and potential conflicts with the City Standing
	Committees and FCM Board of Directors meetings.
	Cancellation of the meeting is also not a viable option as it
	would leave an eleven week gap between the July 9th and
	September 24 th meetings, if the Commission proceeds with
	Recommendation No. 2 above.
