BACKGROUND

The Auditor General, Jeff Griffiths, conducted an audit to determine the extent to which the City has achieved its access, equity and human rights goals. A report dated October 14, 2008, was provided to the City of Toronto Audit Committee with various recommendations. Specifically, recommendation No. 3 requests:

"the major Agencies, Boards, Commissions and Corporations to provide an annual human rights report to Council detailing the numbers and types of human rights complaints received by the Human Rights Tribunal of Ontario involving the respective Agency, Board, Commission and Corporation, and the complaint resolutions and associated costs."

DISCUSSION

At its meeting of May 28, 2009, the Commission approved the recommendation whereby the TTC is to provide to City Council an annual Human Rights report on complaints filed with the Human Rights Tribunal of Ontario against the TTC. The report is to include the number and types of complaints received, with resolutions and associated costs.

JUSTIFICATION

It is recommended the Confidential Attachment be forwarded to City Council through the appropriate Committee.
