Since the mid-1970's, there have been numerous planning studies conducted regarding the preferred location of the bus terminal from the private carriers', the City of Toronto's and Metrolinx's perspectives.

### DISCUSSION

Options for the future of GO Transit's bus operations at Union Station that include the presence of the intercity bus companies are presently under study.

### JUSTIFICATION

TTC is participating with Metrolinx to determine the location and feasibility of a new permanent intercity bus terminal.
