VENTILATION FAN ASSEMBLIES

CONTRACT A60-18

ACTION ITEM

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Commission authorize the award of a contract to Twin City Clarage Inc. in the amount of \$13,966,528.80 for Contract A60-18, Design, Supply and Testing of Subway Ventilation Fan Assemblies.

FUNDING

Sufficient funds for this expenditure are included in the TTC's 2012-2016 Capital Program, which was approved by the Commission on December 14, 2011 and by Council on January 17, 2012. Funding for this work is included in the Toronto-York Spadina Subway Extension Project (Category – Expansion), as referenced in the 2011-2015 Capital Program books noted on pages 1447-1449R.

BACKGROUND

The TTC is planning the design and construction of an underground subway line from the existing Downsview Station on the Spadina Line located in the City of Toronto, to the proposed Vaughan Metropolitan Centre located in the City of Vaughan, Region of York. The new 8.6 km long line will include both tunnelled and cut and cover sections.

The Contract designated as A60-18, is for the design, manufacture, fabrication, quality assurance, commissioning, testing and delivery of the subway ventilation fan assemblies for the Toronto-York Spadina Subway Extension Project.

DISCUSSION

Specifications and drawings were prepared for Contract A60-18 and a Request for Proposals (RFP) was posted on MERX as of October 23, 2012. Seven companies downloaded the proposal documents from the MERX website, out of which one of these acceptable companies named in the contract documents submitted a bid as summarized on the attached Appendix A.

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FlaktWoods Group Inc. and TLT Babcock were the other two acceptable companies however, FlaktWoods Group Inc. did not submit a bid as they sent a letter stating they were not willing to provide any type of bonding requirements and TLT Babcock did not pick up documents.

The proposal submitted by Twin City Clarage Inc. was the only proposal received. Upon completion of the evaluation they were determined to be acceptable. They did not state any exceptions or qualifications and they have satisfactorily provided fans for the Commission in the past.

The Agreement to Bond submitted by Twin City Clarage Inc. covers a Performance Bond and was submitted by Travellers Insurance Company of Canada, who has been verified as a Surety Company licensed to transact business under the Insurance Act of Ontario. As such they are considered financially capable of performing the work.

The successful Proponent will be required to execute a Performance Bond for 50% of the contract value.

JUSTIFICATION

The bid submitted by Twin City Clarage Inc. is the only acceptable bid received.
