#### **BACKGROUND**

On April 27, 2009, the Board approved the declaration of ten properties which were either held on title by the TTC or under its jurisdiction, as surplus for transfer or turnover to Build Toronto Inc. Eight of these properties are TTC commuter parking lots. In addition, a number of other TTC commuter parking lots have already closed or will close due to the Metrolinx Eglinton Crosstown LRT or TTC capital project construction.

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
