

The Board at its meeting of Wednesday, May 28, 2014 adopted the following member motion:

1. Withdrawal of the 5-part recommendation on Page 3 of the motion.
2. That Transportation Services, through the Public Works & Infrastructure Committee, be requested to provide updates to the TTC Board every 3 months on what action has been taken on City Council's October 8, 2013 resolution on Item NM39.16 – Maintaining Traffic Flow in the Downtown Area. Furthermore, that the information as set out in the motion be submitted along with this resolution to the Public Works & Infrastructure Committee for their consideration.
3. That the City of Toronto be requested to establish a Road Management Policy Task Force for the purpose of developing a comprehensive plan for the above the surface management of City of Toronto Streets.
4. The task force be under the egis of Public Works but be jointly sponsored by Public Works, TTC and Planning with staff representation from Police Services, Toronto Parking Authority, Licensing and Standards, EMS and such other department as determined by the City Manager.
5. The task force be directed to:
 - a) Establish a set of principles and priorities to govern the management of Toronto roads.
 - b) From these develop a comprehensive Road and Congestion management plan for the City of Toronto.
 - c) Review all existing traffic management, parking, standing, stopping and loading bylaws
 - d) Seek public input from a wide range of stakeholder groups and the general public
 - e) Explore all available technologies
 - f) Make recommendations to Council through the Public Works Committee.
