## Summary

At its meeting on September 10, 2015, the Human Resources & Labour Relations Committee requested that TTC Staff provide them with pay data for unionized Bus Drivers working in the private sector, compared to the average hourly wage of unionized employees overall.

This request was spawned by the current review being conducted of the TTC's Executive Compensation Program by the Hay Group Consultants.

A brief review of private sector organizations in Ontario employing unionized Bus Drivers provided the following data.
