Re: Accessible Parking Spaces at the Downsview Subway Station

Background:

There have been concerns raised by users of the Downsview Subway Station with the availability and location of accessible parking spaces in the parking lot at the Station.

Currently there are several accessible parking spaces in the north end of the public parking lot at the station. There is concern however that these accessible spots are not close enough to the actual subway station and the walk required cannot be completed by all. There are accessible spots in the Passenger Pick-up and Drop-off lot closer to the station, however these spaces have a correspondingly short parking time limit.

Recommendation:

That the TTC Board direct staff to investigate and report back to the TTC Board on the feasibility of adding accessible parking spaces closer to Downsview Station entrance to better accommodate all users of the TTC.
