### Issue Background

The Greater Toronto's Top Employers award is a project of Mediacorp Canada Inc., and has become a benchmark in the Greater Toronto Area for workplace best-practices. To be recognized as one of Greater Toronto's Top Employers the TTC was evaluated using eight criteria:

- 1. Physical workplace;
- 2. Work atmosphere and social;
- 3. Health, financial and family benefits;
- 4. Vacation and time off;
- 5. Employee communications;
- 6. Performance management;
- 7. Training and skills development;
- 8. Community involvement.

Some of the reasons why the TTC was selected as one of Greater Toronto's Top

- The TTC encourages ongoing employee development with tuition subsidies for courses both related and unrelated to an employees' current position (up to \$3,500 per year) and a variety of in-house and online training options, including apprenticeship opportunities;
- In addition to contributions to a defined benefit pension plan, the TTC helps employees prepare for the future with retirement planning assistance and health benefits that extend to retirees (with no age limit);
- As part of the organization's efforts to support its diverse workforce and customer base, the TTC created a Diversity and Inclusion Lens to encourage employees to think about the unintended impacts their decisions may have on diverse groups.
