

## **TTC Board Governance and 2019 Meeting Schedule**

**Date:** January 10, 2019

To: TTC Board

From: Chief Executive Officer

### **Summary**

The Province of Ontario's *Better Local Government, 2018*, reduced the number of municipal wards in Toronto from 47 to 25. The majority of TTC Board members are members of City Council. The reduction of the size of City Council will place increased demands on Council Members' time to carry out their City business, legislative and constituency related duties. This report provides options for efficiencies for TTC Board meetings and recommends a schedule of meetings for 2019.

### Recommendations

It is recommended that the TTC Board:

- 1. Appoint up to three (3) Board members to the Audit & Risk Management Committee and appoint a Chair to the Committee from among the appointed Committee members.
- 2. Dissolve the Budget Committee and appoint up to two (2) Board members to a Budget Working Group.
- 3. Dissolve the Human Resources and Labour Relations Committee.
- 4. Discontinue the annual Board strategy meeting and refer any relevant agenda items to regularly scheduled meetings.
- 5. Direct staff to report back in Q1 2019 on opportunities for increased efficiencies through staff delegations.
- 6. Approve the 2019 meeting dates for the TTC Board and the Audit & Risk Management Committee, as follows:

TTC Board:

January 24June 12November 12February 27July 10December 12

April 11 September 24 May 8 October 21

Audit & Risk Management Committee:

February 19 September 19 May 29 December 9

7. Authorize that the published schedule serves as notice for these meetings.

### **Financial Summary**

Board members are not paid per diems for their service on Committees of the Board or Working Groups, therefore there are no financial impacts.

City Council members do not receive any additional payment for attending Board meetings or meetings of Committees of the Board.

Any financial impacts resulting from the adoption of efficiency measures through staff delegation will be reported back to the Board in Q1 2019 should the Board adopt staff's recommendation to report back on options for increased accountability measures being exercised by staff.

The Chief Financial Officer has reviewed this report and agrees with the financial impact information.

### **Equity/Accessibility Matters**

TTC Board and Committee meetings are held at Toronto City Hall or the TTC Head Office location (1900 Yonge Street). These facilities are accessible and attendant support services are on-hand to assist members of the public with personal care needs.

Board meetings held at Toronto City Hall are also live-streamed to the TTC's YouTube Channel.

The 2019 meeting schedule avoids meetings on days of cultural or religious significance.

## **Decision History**

The Audit Committee's mandate was expanded in May 2015 to include Risk Management which resulted in the Committee being renamed the Audit & Risk Management Committee. In addition, the Board established a Human Resources and Labour Relations Committee.

### **Issue Background**

The City Manager and City Clerk prepared a report recommending changes to the City's governance structure in order to calibrate the governance structure for the reduced Council size. The report, entitled <u>Recalibrating City Council's Governance System for 26 Members</u> (http://app.toronto.ca/tmmis/viewAgendaltemHistory.do?item=2019.CC1.1) was considered by City Council at its meeting on December 4 – 5, 2018. The report also specifically addresses the TTC Board by reducing the Council Members appointed to the Board from seven to five.

At its meeting on December 13, 2018, City Council adopted a motion recommending the appointment of a sixth Council member to the TTC Board, thus amending the Board's overall composition from eleven to ten members (six Council members and four Citizen appointments).

#### Comments

In consideration of changes to the Board's composition and recognizing that Council Members' will have increased demands on their time, staff have reviewed where opportunities may exist for efficiencies to be implemented that would reduce the time commitment required of Board Members while still ensuring appropriate oversight and decision making opportunities.

#### Committees of the Board

The TTC Board had three Committees during its 2014-2018 term: Audit & Risk Management Committee, Budget Committee and Human Resources and Labour Relations Committee. Each Committee was comprised of a maximum of five Board members (less than half the total Board composition). Audit & Risk Management Committee met quarterly. Budget Committee and the Human Resources and Labour Relations Committee meetings were scheduled on a quarterly basis until 2017 when the Board approved scheduling meetings on an as required basis. This was due to the fact that meetings of both Committees, when scheduled, were often rescheduled or

cancelled due to timing issues associated with factors such as collective bargaining and the City budget process.

Recommendations related to each Committee are below.

### Audit & Risk Management Committee

The Audit & Risk Management Committee assists the Board in fulfilling its oversight responsibilities in the following areas:

- financial reporting process and financial statements
- external audit of the financial statements
- enterprise risk management
- system of internal control
- audit function
- regulatory audits
- compliance with laws and regulations
- internal special investigation activities

This Committee should be continued, with a further governance review being conducted to determine which matters should be handled solely by the Audit & Risk Management Committee and which items are to be forwarded to the Board for consideration.

Currently the Audit & Risk Management Committee is composed of five Members. This represents over half of the new TTC Board membership and is too large. The composition of the Audit & Risk Management Committee should be reduced to three members to reflect the overall reduction in the size of the TTC Board.

#### **Budget Committee**

The Budget Committee establishes and makes recommendations to the Board regarding the budget strategy for the annual TTC and Wheel-Trans Operating Budgets and the 10-Year Capital Plan. The Committee is also responsible for reviewing detailed budget presentations from staff regarding ridership and revenue forecasts, proposed service levels, workforce requirements and operating and capital expenditure needs.

Staff recommend that this Committee be dissolved in favour of establishing a Working Group comprised of a maximum of two Board members and TTC staff. The two Board members will provide expertise and assistance to staff in preparation for the annual budget process. This approach lessens the frequency of formal meetings while still aligning with the City's budget reporting requirements and timing.

### Human Resources and Labour Relations Committee

The Human Resources and Labour Relations Committee assists the Board in fulfilling its obligations relating to labour relations, human resources and health and safety. The Committee is also responsible for the performance evaluation and compensation strategy for the Chief Executive Officer, review of succession planning, compensation strategies and other labour matters and reviewing the mandate for collective agreement negotiations.

The overall responsibility for human resources and labour relations lies with the Board, therefore staff recommend dissolving this Committee and forwarding any items that

would typically be within the Committee's mandate to the Board. The TTC has just concluded its latest round of collective bargaining and has negotiated and arbitrated contract terms with its Unions. Should the Board deem it necessary, it can establish a time-limited special Committee or Working Group to address bargaining specific issues when the TTC approaches the expiration of these current collective agreements with the Unions.

### **Opportunities for Board Meeting Efficiencies**

In order to manage the number of items being presented to the Board for consideration while simultaneously seeking opportunities to improve decision making efficiency, it is recommended that staff begin to review options where delegated authority from the Board to staff is feasible. A report from staff on this matter can be presented to the Board for its consideration in Q1 2019.

### **Schedule of Meetings**

The proposed schedule has been prepared subject to the Board's adoption of Recommendations 1-4 in this report.

As in previous years, the 2019 Board meeting schedule has been developed based on a monthly meeting format. There are no meetings scheduled for the month of March and August. TTC Board meetings have been scheduled ahead of City Executive Committee meetings whenever possible in order to facilitate transmittal of key items.

A separate Board meeting for strategy purposes is no longer included in the schedule in an effort to reduce the total number of Board meetings and to lessen the time commitment required of the majority of Board members.

In accordance with its Terms of Reference, there are four recommended meeting dates for the Audit & Risk Management Committee during the months of February, May, September and December. This schedule takes into consideration anticipated timing of items such as annual financial and external auditor reporting.

Meetings of the TTC's two subsidiary companies, the Toronto Transit Commission Insurance Company Limited and the Toronto Coach Terminal Inc. are scheduled in advance of the February and June Board meetings. These meetings are noted on the 2019 Schedule of Meetings (calendar view), included as Attachment 1 to this report.
