TTC Board Decision

The TTC Board, at its meeting on February 25, 2020, adopted the following:

Advice and Other Information

The TTC Board also adopted the following Member motions:

- 1. That the TTC Board direct the TTC CEO to align specific reporting timelines of the TTC's Revenue Protection Strategy and the TTC's Fare Strategy, as follows:
 - a) Recommendation #27 from the Auditor General's Report related to By-law No. 1 be reported on as part of the TTC Fare Strategy in Q4 2020.
- 2. That the TTC Board request staff to report back in Q4 2020 as part of the TTC Fare Strategy on the cost for Torontonians to ride the TTC for free.
- 3. That TTC staff report back in Q2 2020 on fare evasion, as follows:
 - a) TTC policies on fine amounts and charges; and
 - b) Data on fare enforcement, including fines and charges levied in 2019.
- 4. That the TTC Chair strike a Working Group to provide advice on the TTC Revenue Protection Strategy as it progresses through the steps outlined in the February 2020 report, and that the Working Group meet on a quarterly basis.
