

Fitness for Duty Policy: Litigation Update

TTC Board Decision

The TTC Board, at its meeting on January 27, 2020, adopted the following:

It is recommended that:

- 1. The TTC Board adopt the confidential recommendations set out in Confidential Attachment 1;
- 2. The purchase order with external counsel, Blakes LLP, be extended to December 31, 2022; and
- Authorize that the information provided in Confidential Attachment 1 remain confidential in its entirety, as it contains information subject to solicitor-client privilege.

Advice and Other Information

The TTC Board also adopted the following Member motions:

It is recommended that:

- 1. The Board directs staff to disclose the financial information in the confidential attachment once the matter has been settled.
- 2. The Board reiterates its support for random drug and alcohol testing at the TTC;
- 3. The Board supports the recommendation of the Auditor General of Ontario;
- 4. The Board supports the efforts of the Ontario government to act on the Auditor General's recommendation;
- 5. Staff contact the Minister of Labour, Minister of Transportation and the Attorney General to express the TTC Board's support for random drug and alcohol testing; and
- 6. Staff work with the Government of Ontario in support of developing a legislative regime that supports random drug and alcohol testing.
