StudentMoveTO (2018-2021)


- Supported by a SSHRC Partnership Development Grant (\$200,000)
- 10 partner universities and Colleges
- 4 partner government and community organizations































What is StudentMoveTO?

• 3-year research and partnership program focusing on an improved understanding of the travel behaviour of 600,000 post-secondary students in the GTHA

 Explore transportation patterns of this important and yet understudied population group, potential social and environmental influences on their travel behaviour, and the effect of students' travel on their social well-being and urban systems

• Through our partnership, this research will create new pathways for public policy, institutional planning and enhanced student support services


State-of-the-art Survey

- October 1, 2019 to November 30, 2019 (except the reading week)
- Customized survey software; including a travel diary
- Reached out to ALL students with help from university/college staff
- Total 18,500 students responded ; 5.8% response rate
- 13,130 respondents attended a campus in Toronto


Qualitative Research

- 40 Interviews since the summer of 2020 and more being planned
- Protocol adjusted to COVID-19 conditions both in terms of the feasibility of interviews and the questions asked
- Topics discussed:
- Accessibility
- 2. Travel distance, time, cost
- 3. Safety
- 4. Technology and shared mobility modes
- 5. Travel under COVID-19 restrictions


Map of all students household locations and campuses




Percentage of students whose main commute mode to campus is TTC
