Reason for Confidential Information

Summary

On October 28, 2021, the TTC was subject to a cybersecurity breach. The organization mobilized to respond to the immediate threat to the TTC's IT network and systems, and to mitigate impacts to the TTC's day-to-day business operations. The confidential attachment provides the Board with an update on the current status of the cybersecurity breach and work completed to date.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the TTC Board:

1. Receive the in-camera presentation, noting that it is to remain confidential in its entirety as it contains information that is subject to solicitor-client privilege.
