### Advancing Automated Streetcar Enforcement to Address Urgent Safety Concerns

#### Recommendation

The TTC Board requests that:

1. TTC staff, in consultation with the relevant staff at the City of Toronto, report to the October 29 TTC Board meeting on the process underway for procuring and installing automated enforcement cameras on all streetcars under the *Moving Ontarians More Safely Act* and strategies to process all fines issued from automated enforcement cameras on streetcars.

#### Summary

---

On September 8, 2024, a TTC user was struck by a car while exiting a streetcar at the intersection of Bathurst Street and College Street (Ward 11, University-Rosedale). It is unacceptable that drivers continue to violate the law and endanger the lives of transit users. The police are too short-staffed to adequately enforce traffic laws without the extensive use of automated enforcement cameras.

My motion requests that the TTC use its powers under the [Moving Ontarians More Safely Act](#) to install automated enforcement cameras on streetcars to keep Torontonians safe and allow them to use our streetcar system with confidence.
