



Student safety checklist

1. Personal safety

Don't run in front of or next to a bus or streetcar

Never try to board or exit a vehicle when the doors are closing

Make sure traffic has stopped before exiting a streetcar

Stay behind the curb at stops and the yellow line on platforms

Never go onto the tracks for any reason, speak to a TTC employee if you dropped something

Remove your headphones or lower the volume in stations to hear important announcements

2. Consideration for others

Wait for others to exit a bus, streetcar, or subway before boarding

Wait for people using mobility devices to board first

Move behind the white line toward the back of the bus/streetcar after boarding

Don't block doors, aisles or seats with your belongings

Offer your seat to those who need it, such as people with disabilities, seniors, or pregnant persons

Use headphones when listening to music or watching your device

Don't leave garbage behind
