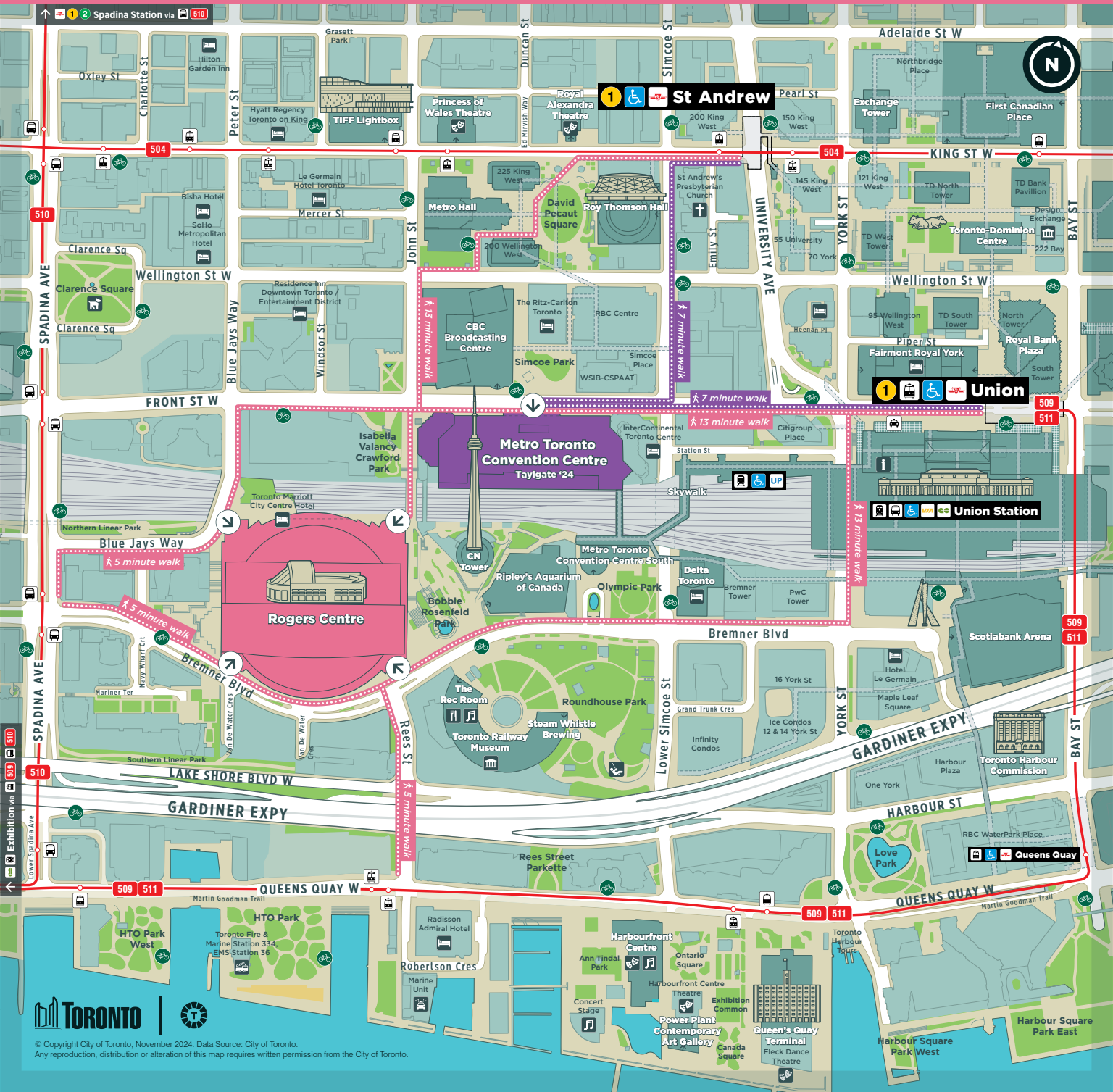
Extra buses will be available after the event on Spadina Avenue, travelling directly to **Spadina Station** (Lines **1** and **2**).

Fare payment tips!

Pay your fare; you must have Proof-of-Payment on the TTC.



Your tapped PRESTO, credit/debit card, or mobile device is your Proof-of-Payment. If you pay with cash, get a paper transfer from the operator, or transfer machine at a station or on a streetcar.

You can pay your fare in the following ways:

Fare type	Adult	Youth (13–19)	Senior (65+)
Credit / debit (adult only)	\$3.30	-	-
PRESTO card	\$3.30	\$2.35	\$2.25
PRESTO one-ride ticket*	\$3.35	-	-
PRESTO two-ride ticket*	\$6.70	-	-
PRESTO day pass ticket*	\$13.50	-	-
Cash	\$3.35	\$2.40	\$2.30

* PRESTO Tickets can only be used by one person per trip. Two-ride and day pass tickets cannot be used by more than one person during the same trip.

Two-Hour Transfer

Take advantage of the Two-Hour Transfer to use the TTC as much as you like without being charged another fare.



*Does not apply to customers paying with cash.
Must be within two hours from your first tap.*
