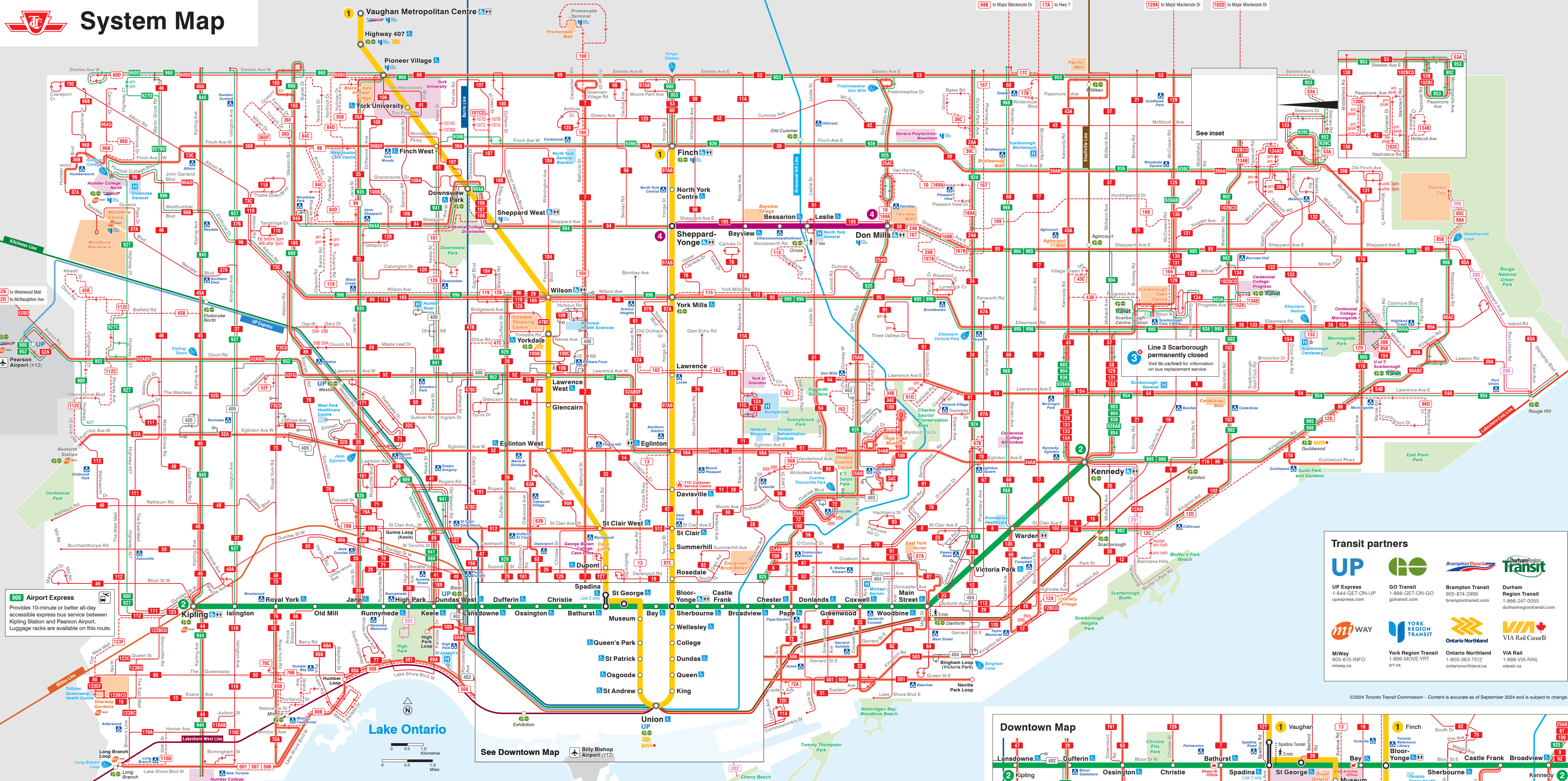


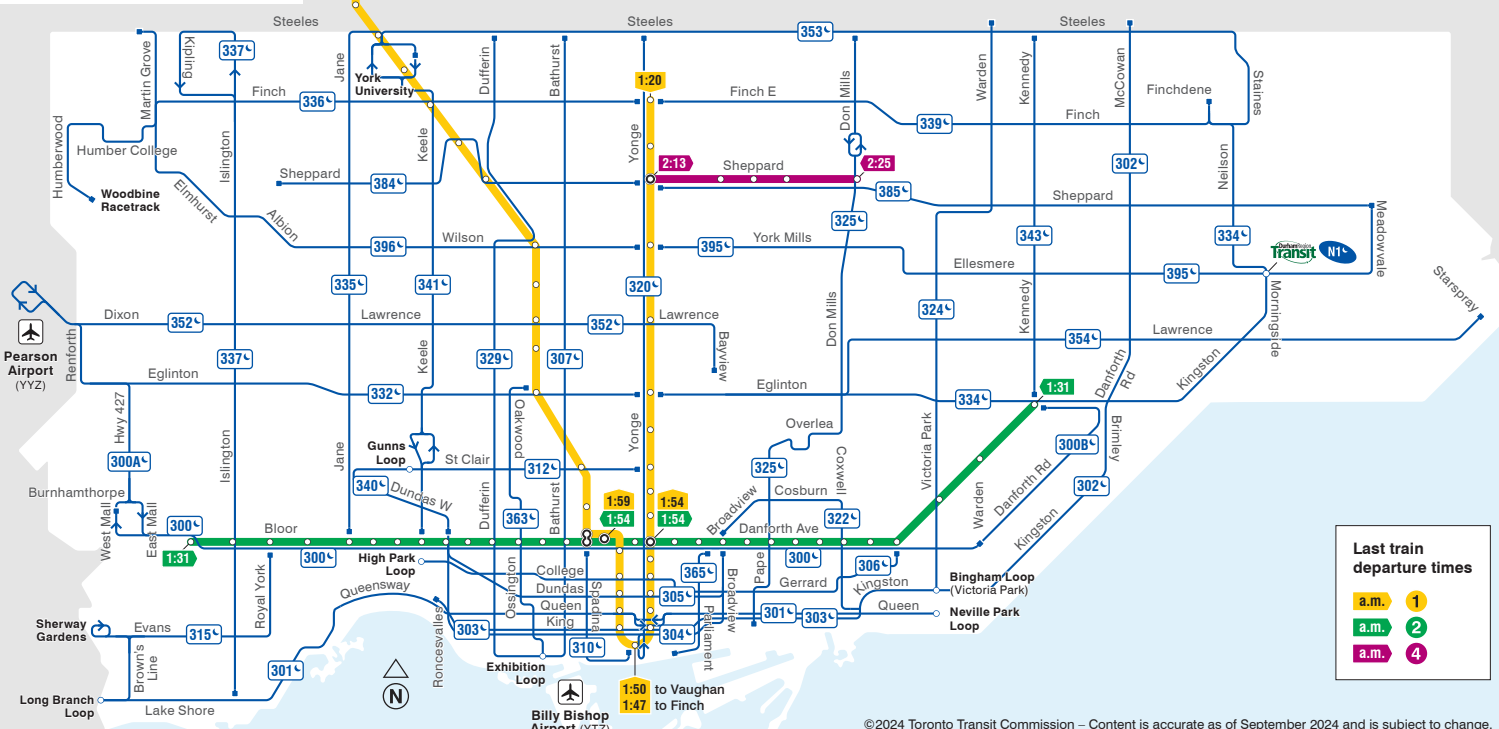
System Map

Local service

- Ten-Minute Network** (501, 30): 10-minute or better service from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m. Monday to Saturday; operates from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. on Sundays.
- Regular service** (119): Operates all day, every day, until 1 a.m.
- Limited service** (119): Operates at limited times of day. Frequency of service varies by route. Some service does not operate during all periods.

Special services

- Express Network** (905): Express bus service, serving select stops. Frequency of service varies by route. Some service does not operate during all periods.
- Seasonal service** (200): Operates at limited times of the year. For details on periods of operation, refer to route pages on the ttc.ca website.
- Community Bus** (404): Neighbourhood midday service, Monday to Friday, connecting seniors' residences with local points of interest. Flag down anywhere along route.
- Blue Night Network** (310): 30-minute or better service, from approximately 1:30 a.m. to the start of subway service (approximately 6 a.m.) on weekdays and Saturdays; 8 a.m. on Sundays.
